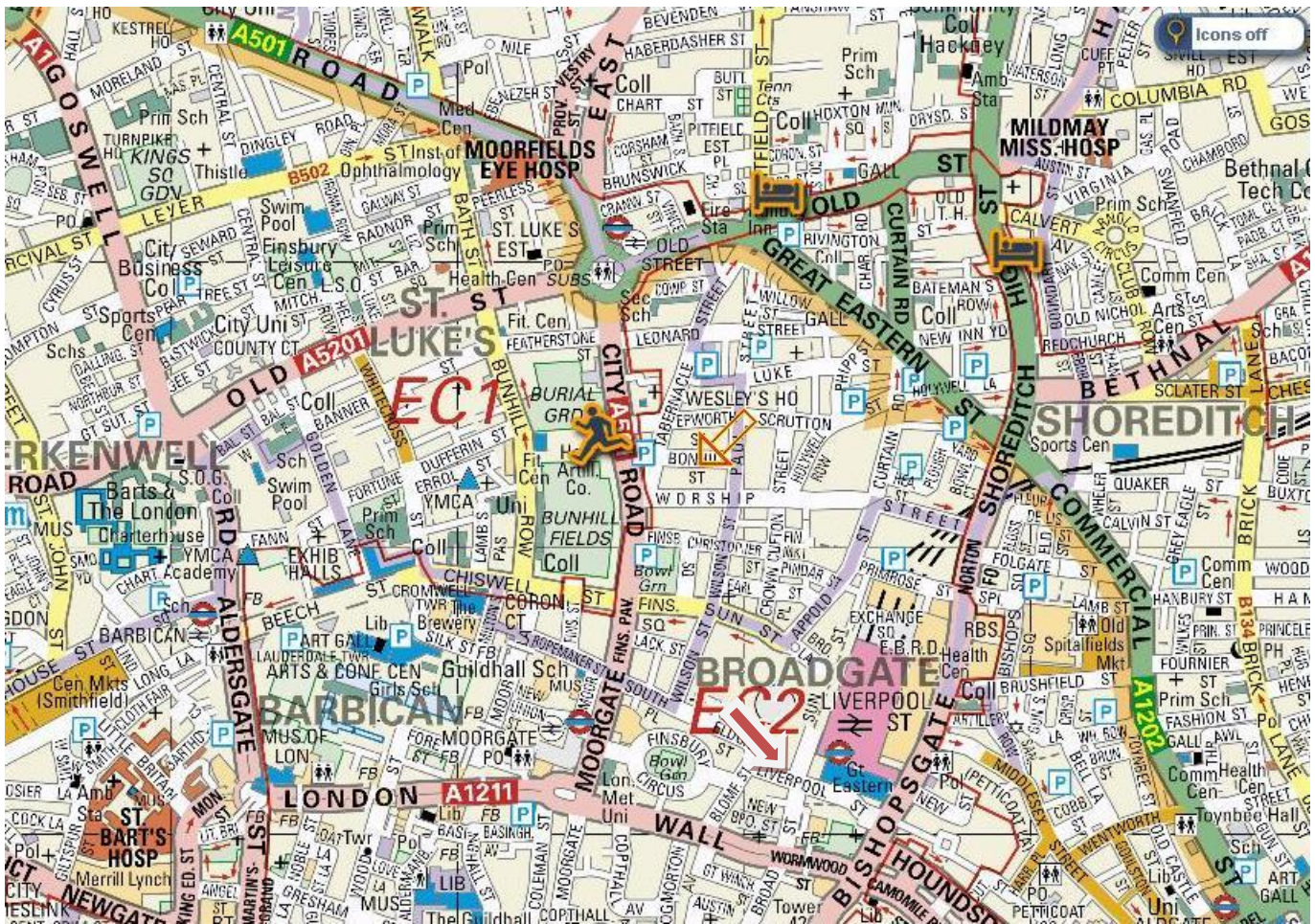

### Lunch:
